The law was introduced in response to Deseret News's attempt to obtain the information, aiming to keep NIL agreements confidential and protect student-athletes' privacy

And in Ohio, there's a new bill on the table, House Bill 660 that would let universities negotiate NIL deals directly with student-athletes. The bill would allow schools to pay players directly or support independent collectives that fund them. Exciting changes ahead!

NIL continues to make a positive impact on athletes and communities across the country. At OSU, we're excited to see how NIL can further our goals. If you're a student at OSU, don't miss out on joining the movement!
